## **BEFORE**

I highly recommend taking the personality test yourself before assigning it to your students because a) it's really cool and freakishly accurate b) it will help you familiarize yourself with the test and how it works and c) it will allow you to model with your results when your students take the test.

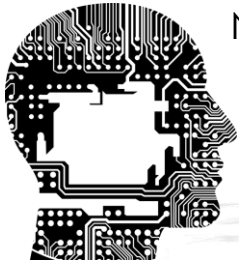
Also, make sure that all students have access to a computer/device. Send/share the link to them for easy access.

## **DURING**

If you have access to a projector/smart board, it helps to show the students the website and do a bit of modeling—show the students the percentages, the sections they will be reading, etc. But there's not much to do when students are taking the test and reflecting. 😊 I usually enjoy walking around and chatting with individual students when I see their results up on their screen. They're often shocked because the results are so spot-on! It's as if someone has been spying on them through their screens!

## **AFTER**

There are a few options for what to do after the test! You could facilitate a whole-class discussion about what the students learned, organize them for small-group discussions, or follow it up with a creative or introspective writing task.

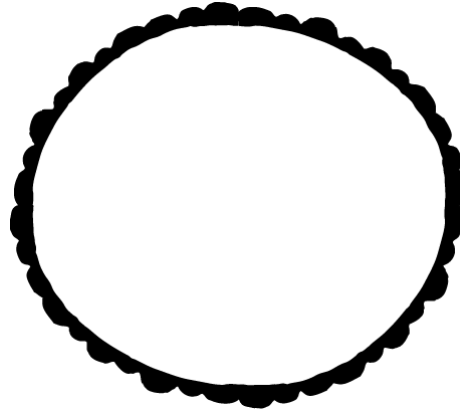

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
