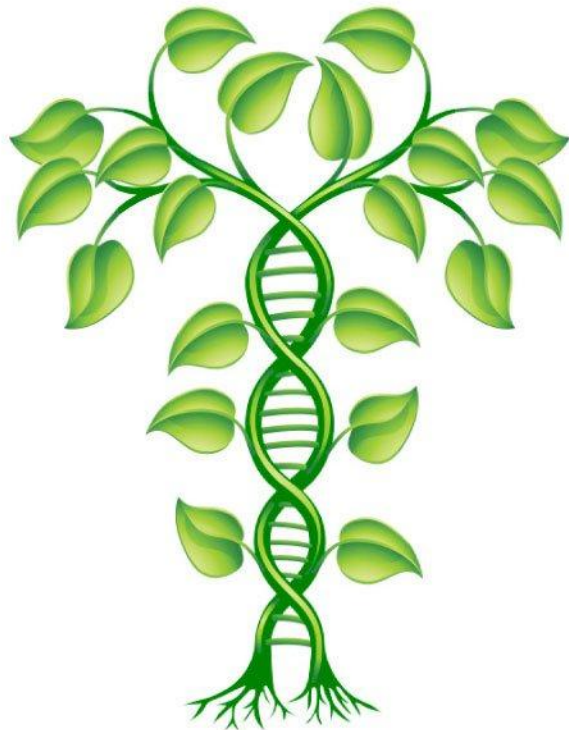


WELCOME TO Dual Credit Biology
